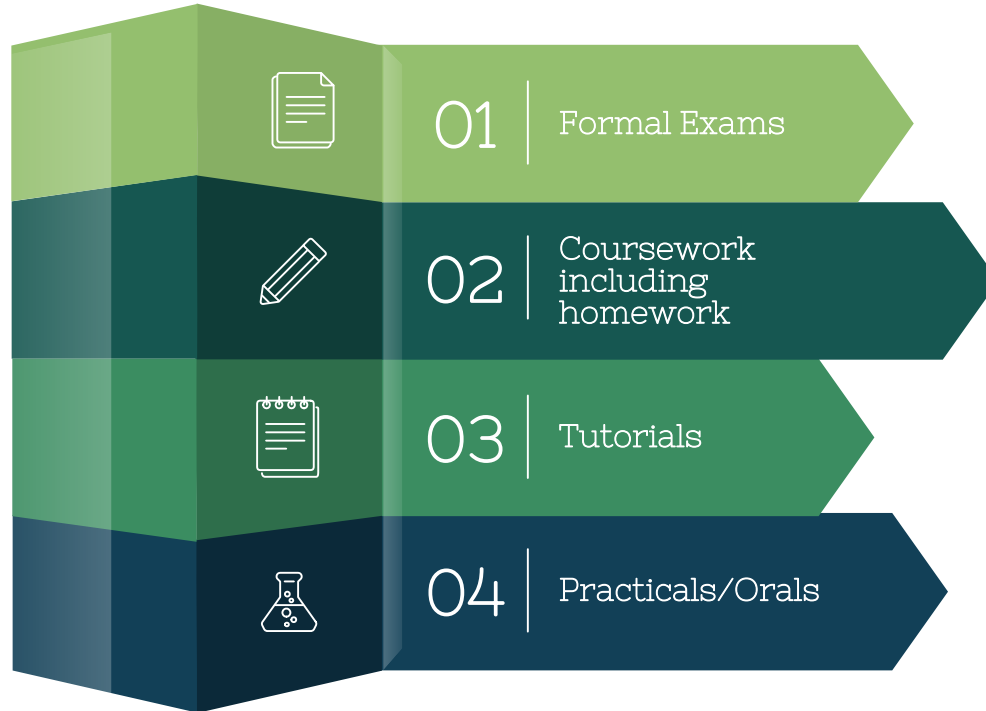

Excused Absences

- MUST be covered by an EXCUSED NOTE
- EXCUSED NOTES Do NOT cover sickness



Absences due to Sickness

- MUST be covered by a BLUE Medical Certificate
- Certificates MUST be presented within FIVE (5) days
- Guardians are ALWAYS informed if students leave school early due to illness
- Students are ADVISED to present Medical Consent Forms for any Medical conditions that they may suffer from.



Medical Appointments

- Hospital/Health Centre Appointments MUST be covered by a Blue Medical Certificate
- Students MUST present Proof of Attendance at Hospital /Health Centre Appointments stating time of entry / exit
- Medical Appointments at PRIVATE DOCTORS / PHARMACIES MUST be carried out AFTER School hours.

- Focuses on soft skills such as creativity, leadership, motivation, teamwork and communication.

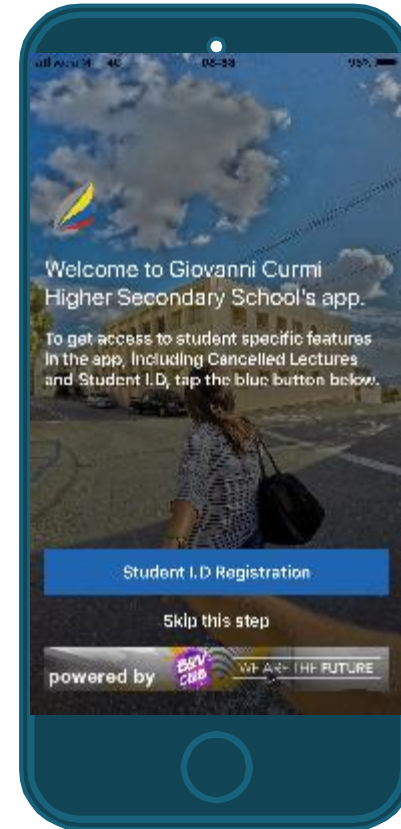


Outreach Programme
